2. Create and promote an ordinary living environment for service users, enabling them to develop the skills required for an ordinary life.
3. Play a key role in a team that encourages the service users to express their wishes and needs and make informed choices.
4. Facilitate client participation in the care process.
5. Create care plans, risk assessments and conduct audits.

6. Liaise closely with partner agencies/professionals involved in the service user's care to ensure objectives of individual support plans are pursued.
7. Co-ordinate and supervise any temporary care staff, trainees or volunteers drawn in to support the care home.
8. Facilitate both on and off-site social networks, as well as recreational activities.
